In order to give us maximum flexibility when custom-designing education programs for our clients, we are assembling a pool of rural properties around Queensland representing as wide a range as possible of different ecosystems and habitat types to use as mix-and-match modules when designing educational programs to meet the specific requirements of each of our clients.

Our clients may include people interested in experiencing and learning about Australia's unique natural features or cultural heritage in a relaxed recreational manner (e.g. ecotourists); they may be studying subjects such as Australian geology, biology, ecology, environmental management, or cultural heritage as part of a formal university study program; they may have specific interests in certain aspects of Australian natural history (e.g. birdwatchers); or anything in between.

In addition to assembling a pool of ecosystems, habitats and culturally interesting locations on private lands to which we can have access for our educational programs, we may also require a variety of other local support services. These services include logistic support (living accommodation, space to accommodate indoor meeting/learning activities, catering and transport), and people with specialised local knowledge and experience to assist with teaching and guiding. NaRLA's possible need for a variety of local support services offers opportunities for landholders to establish co-operative partnerships with other landholders or service providers in their local community to jointly meet our needs.
